# Fall Painting Project at the Church



A major summer and fall activity has been painting the outside of the church. Our church building is actually a large, 2 story house with 23 windows of various sizes. Fifteen of our church members have pitched in to power blast and paint the roof, scrape and paint the metal bars on the windows, scale scaffolding and ladders to paint the building, and do all the extras like trim. It has been a challenging experience and one that has required patience and perseverance. We are thankful for each one who has willingly served the Lord by caring for His House. And we thank the Lord for His protection as well.

One of the unique aspects of the ministry is the way the church provides transportation for many of our members. At first glance, this does not seem to be a problem. However, one of the challenges the church faces is the rising cost of gasoline and the more frequent

repairs as the church vans become older. The vans were obtained with Campbell Soup Labels in the 90's. Whether it be Sunday Worship or Thursday evening Bible Study, four or five vans provide transportation covering approximately 200 miles for each service! With gas prices rising more than 60%, the cost of running the vehicles has increased dramatically. Also, this year the church has had to make major repairs on the vans costing over \$8,000. In an attempt to bring these costs under control and to offset some of these expenses, the church will be selling two of our large 15 passenger vans.
